

Environmental Policy Statement

Alun Griffiths (Contractors) Limited is a civil engineering company based in Abergavenny, South Wales. It undertakes civil engineering projects and road surfacing work for Local Authorities, The Highways Agency, The Environment Agency and other public and private clients across Wales, the West Midlands and the West of England. The work includes highway schemes, utility works, river works and work for Network Rail.

Alun Griffiths (Contractors) Limited recognises that it needs to acknowledge its responsibility to the Environment. The Company has, therefore, developed an environmental management system which satisfies the requirements of BS EN ISO14001: 2015 "Environmental Management Systems", which it will apply to all its projects in order to control their impact on the environment, and in turn make a contribution to achieving savings in the material used.

The Company will comply with all relevant environmental legislation and other requirements of a similar nature.

The Company makes every effort to conserve the use of material and energy and, where viable, collects waste material for recycling and uses materials from sustainable sources that may also be reusable or recyclable.

Whilst construction is in progress all reasonable precautions are taken against environmental damage, disruption or nuisance on or adjoining the project site; this particularly applies to working on or adjacent to SSSI areas. Measures are taken to prevent pollution by unnecessary effluents, noise, fumes, dust or the disposal of construction materials.

The Company's environmental policy is specifically established for each project through its own individual environmental

plan. This plan identifies the environmental aspects associated with the project and where the environmental impacts are likely to occur. From this to protect the environment, action can be established, planned into the works, and monitored during the business of the work.

An essential feature of the environmental management system is a commitment to improving environmental performance. This is achieved by setting annual environmental improvement objectives and targets which are regularly monitored and reviewed. The objectives and targets are publicised throughout the company and all staff are committed to their achievement.

This Policy and the obligations and responsibilities required by the environmental management system have been communicated to all employees and others who work on behalf of the company. The Policy is available to the public on request.
